If you change your perception of the world, you will see more. The field poppy is a portrait of a common plant.

Known? Or maybe the unknown?

Ordinary? Or perhaps not ordinary

The photo comes from the series of photos entitled: Meadow stories that show the potential of meadow plants that are often regarded as weeds that are passed by and unnoticed every day. The work: An ordinary field poppy becomes the beginning of the author's search for a way of showing the sensual feeling of the world and admiration for the beauty of nature - "ordinary flora" - in the photographic and painting approach. One could say that the presented works are paintings: "portraits" of common plants in the play of colors and light. Plants found in their natural habitat: in the field, meadow, forest, caught in the frame at different times of the day: in the morning, at dusk, at night, in full sun or after a storm, testify to their existence and their uniqueness.

It worked, the weather app predicted a lot of fog the next day at sunrise. I got on the train and travelled over 400 km. At four o'clock in the morning, I set off to Łęgi Rogalińskie. The reality exceeded my expectations, it was the most beautiful sunrise I have ever seen. The sun's rays broke through the thick fog and the branches of the old oaks, and the gold poured into the air. I admired and photographed to keep this fairy-tale view forever, which was a feast for the eyes and soul. Additionally, apart from a deer, there was no living soul nearby, only peace and birds singing. Can you wish for more? Nature is amazing!




Sleeping Beauty

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


Helena Barbagelata








Wioletta Baudur




Saskia Petrenz
